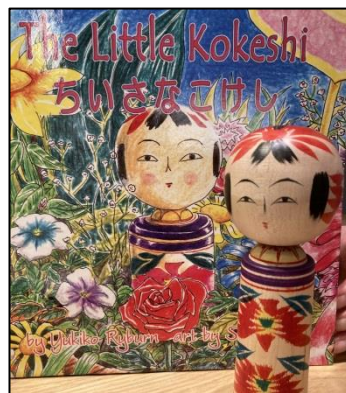


The Cincinnati Asian Art Society Presents:
